Connect and Thrive: Moree youth empowered to shape their future

Monday, 17 November 2025

Delivered by the NSW Office for Youth, Connect and Thrive: Pathways is a direct response to feedback from the 2024 Your Voice, Our Future consultation and the NSW Youth Summit, where young people called for meaningful, face-to-face engagement with government in their communities.

Targeted at young people aged 15 to 20, the event will feature interactive workshops focused on creating positive relationships with peers and building strong community networks.

The sessions are designed to give young people the confidence to connect with local employers, community organisations and government agencies - not just on the day, but beyond the event as they continue to build their future pathways.

NSW Advocate for Children and Young People, Zoë Robinson said the event is a direct response to what young people have asked for.

“In Moree, we’re bringing together young people, local leaders and employers to spark real conversations and open doors to real opportunities. This is what youth engagement should look like - local, meaningful and driven by the voices of young people themselves.”
